Standard Operating Protocols

Officials: **Judges, Technical Delegates**

Category: **Accommodation**

The following policy for accommodation applies to Judges and Technical Delegates working at the Canadian Freestyle FIS NorAms, Canadian Freestyle National Championships, Canadian Freestyle Junior National Championships, Canadian Series and any other "national" level event as defined by the CFSA:

1. Judges:

- a. The Head Judge will recommend rooming assignments to the Organizing Committee following this policy.
- b. Accommodations will only be provided for the night immediately prior to the first day of official competition to the night of the last day of official competition, inclusive.
 - i. If the appropriate Governing Body (i.e. NorAm Committee or CFSA) approves a training day for the judges, then accommodation shall be provided for the night immediately before the training day, if required.
- c. The Head Judge shall receive an extra night of accommodation for arriving 2 days before the first day of official competition.
- d. Judges shall be accommodated on a double occupancy basis unless the gender mix creates an odd number of males or females.
- e. If an odd number of males or females is created, single rooms shall be provided at no extra cost to the Judges.
- f. Special requests for single occupancy may be granted by the Organizing Committee, but the Judge will be responsible for 50% of the per night cost of the room. Payment will be made to the Organizing Committee upon arrival.
- g. Every Judge must have a bed; pull-out couches are not permitted.
- h. Organizing Committees can accommodate Judges in condominiums provided each Judge has his/her own bed. If male and female judges are accommodated in the same condominium, 2 separate full bathrooms must be available. Male and female judges shall have separate rooms.
- i. Judges may share a room with the Technical Delegate.
- j. Special requests, other than single occupancy requests, shall be decided at the discretion of the Organizing Committee.
- k. Costs are borne by the Organizing Committee.



2. Technical Delegates:

- a. Technical Delegates will be provided accommodation for 2 nights before the start of official training to the last night of official accommodation, inclusive.
- b. Technical Delegates may share a room with the Judge.
- c. The Organizing Committee may provide, at its discretion, single occupancy to the Technical Delegate.
- d. Costs are borne by the Organizing Committee
